

REFRIGERATOR & FREEZER DISPOSAL TIPS

If you experienced a prolonged power outage during the wildfires you may need to dispose of your refrigerator or freezer. Check with your insurance provider regarding replacement coverage.

If it's **SAFE** to open your fridge/freezer:

- Double bag spoiled food and dispose of as regular garbage
- Continue to use your appliance

If it's **UNSAFE** to open your fridge/freezer:

- Seal the doors shut with duct tape
- Label the appliance "contaminated"
- Transport the appliance to a designated landfill or transfer station

Transfer Station and Landfill Locations

***Please note:** There is no fee for contaminated fridge/ freezer disposal at CSRD waste transfer stations.
