

## PET & LIVESTOCK CHECKLIST

### Agricultural Status Assessment Checklist

- Contact [BCSPCA Shuswap](#) (250) 832-7376 for continuing pet support.
- Contact your insurance agent or broker for guidance on beginning the recovery process.
- Assess the area to ensure your own safety.
- Inspect livestock areas and pastures for new hazards and damage such as smouldering tree roots, ash pits and danger trees.
- Inspect fencing for damage related to wildfire activity and document concerns for insurance purposes.
- Document any damage and/ or loss of crops, stored hay, livestock, buildings, fences, or equipment in writing to verify losses.
- Document salvaged items for additional insurance considerations.
- Producers with farm status can connect with BC Ministry of Agriculture and Food (BCMAF), Business Risk Management Branch, (BRMB), for information on the Agri-Stability Program and other BRMB support programs.

### Agriculture Sector Preparedness Tips

- The BC Cattlemen's Association is working with federal and provincial governments on a rapid fire/ drought assessment to improve future AgriRecovery response.
